## **NEW DINING FACILITY FOR**

### **VIVONNE BAY**

A new \$550,000 fully licensed dining facility has been opened at Kangaroo Island's Vivonne Bay Outdoor Education Centre.

SeaLink Travel Group's Chief Executive, Mr Jeff Ellison, said the facility would be a stop-off point for tours of the Island as well as being used by school groups using the Education Centre during the week.

"The facility can cater for groups of up to 100 and will also be available for functions such as weddings and birthdays during the weekend," Mr Ellison said.

"The dining area opens out to a large outdoor balcony overlooking the spectacular Vivonne Bay bushland and its large array of native birds and animals.

Mr Ellison said the Vivonne Bay Centre had also recently opened a new raptor "Birds of Prey" show operated by Mr David Irwin.

The show features hunting birds, such as eagles and hawks, and provides information about their lifestyles and how they hunt.

The raptor show will be held at the Centre each day for tour passengers and for the general public.

The award-winning Vivonne Bay Outdoor Education Centre was established to provide schools, colleges, universities and environmental management groups with a natural environment and wildlife reserve experience and is now operated by SeaLink.

Vivonne Bay has been voted one of Australia's top beaches.
